

## Become a CultureConnect Mentor for our International Students

The purpose of the **USF CultureConnect Mentor** program is to provide a student contact for our international students before they arrive to USF and to assist the students upon their arrival. USF students who are interested in becoming mentors after the beginning of the semester may also apply. The international students have varying degrees of English language proficiency, and many of them will be entering the English Language for Academic Purposes (ELAP) program. ELAP is an intensive English language program that students attend for at least 18 hours per week in order to prepare them for undergraduate or graduate academic coursework at USF. Other international students will be entering directly into USF courses upon their arrival. Many of these international students have never been in the United States before, so being greeted by a welcoming face (and in ideal circumstances, someone they have already "met" via email or social media) can be a great way to ease our students' transitions to a new school and a new country.

The USF CultureConnect Mentors will provide the following services for international students:

- Be the initial USF contact person
  - o Before they arrive to USF, the USF Buddy will contact his/her assigned student via email
- If possible, meet them at the airport upon arrival (transportation from USF will be provided.)
- Assist with pre-arrival questions
- Show them around the campus upon their arrival, especially during their first few days. Take them to lunch or dinner in the cafeteria on their first day on campus
- Help them get any additional essential items they may need. Many students can only bring what fits into 2 suitcases
- Serve as a speaking partner for ELAP students at least once a week for an hour of informal conversation practice or maintain at least bi-weekly contact with your buddy throughout the year
- Attend at least two passport events with your buddy each semester. Invite them to other events/activities

Once a USF student has committed to be a part of the CultureConnect Mentor program, his/her email will be given to the assigned international student. In addition, the USF student will receive the international student's email contact information.

If you are interested in this program, please drop off your application in the IPO, Motherhouse, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor or email it to the IPO.
